### GLOBAL TRAVELLING

The easiest and quickest way to get to Long Marston Airfield is by LiftShare.

#### Liftshare to GlobalGathering:

For the second year running we have joined forces with the National Liftshare Network to offer a cheap and sociable way to get to the festival and in the process cut carbon emissions. You can sign up to the scheme, which safely connects drivers and passengers online by visiting our liftshare page. Liftshare is a fantastic company who will help you meet new people, save money, reduce pollution and save time by cutting congestion. GlobalGathering car share is available for anyone, and is completely free!

The scheme aims to match festival goers together that are travelling in the same direction, helping people to reduce travel costs, making their journey more fun, enabling them to meet new people while doing their bit for the environment by taking as many unnecessarily used cars off the road as possible.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR CARS:

For you lucky few who have a Sat Nav we advise you to follow our directions. Sat Nav systems may direct you to the wrong side of the festival site and take you through heavily congested areas. Our directions have been carefully thought out to help you arrive on site in the shortest possible time.

#### The address of the site is:

Long Matston Airfield, Campden Road, Long Marston CV37 8LL

Travelling by public transport reduces pollution and allows you to beat the queues. Please seriously consider leaving your car at home. If you don't fancy the train or coach you can always contact others travelling to the festival on the car sharing website [www.liftshare.com/sub/176](http://www.liftshare.com/sub/176) or on our website message boards at <http://www.globalgathering.co.uk/forum>

GlobalGathering has put in place a tried and tested traffic routing for people arriving by car to avoid the traffic in Stratford-Upon-Avon town centre. Congestion can be very bad on Friday evenings and during Saturday from midday to late evening. Please follow the GlobalGathering route signage at all times! There are now three entrances to the site and if one entrance is congested, traffic will be diverted to alternative entrances. The traffic team may vary routes in order to help you avoid the worst congestion - so you must follow the signs. They will get you to the event site quicker.

#### From the North ~ Friday & Saturday PM

At Junction 3a on the M42 take the M40 south to junction 15 where you then take the A429 onto the Wellesbourne bypass, and then onto the A3400. Take the A3400 towards Stratford and then the B4623 and follow signs to the event site. You need to look for the sign posts on junction 15 and follow the signed route at the time you arrive.

#### From the North ~ Saturday AM

Leave the M40 at Junction 15 and follow the route signs to the GlobalGathering. You will be directed along the A46 to Stratford town centre on either the A 439 or the A 3400. Follow the route signs through Stratford to pick up the A 3400 south of Stratford. Route signage will direct you off the A 3400 onto the B4632 and then to the site.

#### From the South ~ Friday & Saturday

Leave the M40 at Junction 12 and follow the route signage. Take a left onto the B4451 and then right on to the B4100. Continue up to the island where you take a left on to the B4455 towards Tredington. Turn right onto the A3400 and then left on to the B4632 and follow signs to the festival, and directions given by stewards once on-site.

#### From the M5 ~ Friday & Saturday

Leave the motorway at Junction 9 and follow the A46 towards Stratford-upon-Avon for approximately 15 miles. Turn right at the eighth roundabout towards Bidford on the B439. Drive through Bidford towards Stratford-upon-Avon. Follow this road for about 4 miles and then turn right towards Welford and Long Marston and follow signs to the festival, and directions given by stewards once on-site.



#### Parking:

There is plenty of space to park your car at the festival site. Don't park on verges, in gateways or private roads or you will be towed away by the police. Camping and campfires are not allowed in the car parks. In order to deter thieves it is advisable to leave your glove compartment open and empty, and lock all bags etc in your boot.

In addition a 24hr taxi rank will be provided in the main entrance car park for customers lucky enough to live closer to the event.

## CARRY ON CAMPING!

### Remember NOT to bring the following:

- Offensive weapons or anything that may be considered to be an offensive weapon
- ANY glass containers (eg. alcohol, ketchup, soft drinks in glass bottles)
- No fireworks, flares, laser pens or laser equipment will be allowed on site
- Festivalgoers are only permitted to bring live-in vehicles i.e (campervans) if they have purchased a Cloud 9 ticket package
- Under no circumstances will cars or any other type of motorised vehicle be allowed inside the camping area
- With the exception of Guide Dogs, no animals are allowed on site

### Camping Wristband Exchange

Customers must exchange their ticket for a wristband on entry to the site. This is your only opportunity to obtain a wristband. Keep your ticket and wristbands safe as they will not be replaced under any circumstances and you may be required to show them if asked. Ensure you wear your wristband all weekend, to remove it will invalidate it and you risk being ejected from the festival. Wristbands removed from wrist or tampered with will be rendered invalid and will not be replaced.

Only campers with a campsite wristband can move between the arena and the campsite. Please note that Saturday Tickets are only valid for entry on the date specified on the ticket and do not allow you access to the campsites.

Re-admittance to the site is possible only with a camping wristband. There are NO pass-outs to non-campers.. Only festival campers are allowed in the campsite. Campsites will be lit at night and patrolled by security staff. Use the on-site lockers for any valuables – do not leave anything of value in your tent, and make sure you write your postcode on your camping gear. If you see anything suspicious or something happens to you, please do not be afraid to report it to a member of security or a steward, as they are there to help you and keep you safe.

### Campsite Safety

Camping Gas stoves can be dangerous - if you are bringing gas to the festival please follow the guidelines below:

- Before coming to the festival have your equipment serviced.
- Never light a gas cooker inside your tent.
- Always store any spare canisters out of doors.
- Empty canisters may not be completely empty. Give it a gentle shake and listen for liquid before removing it to check. When you have removed the canister, leave it (upright) outside in the open air for a little while to allow any excess gas to evaporate before throwing it away.
- Never change gas cylinders inside your tent.
- Never hold gas cylinders upside down when changing.
- Never use a naked flame to search for a leak.
- Never put a camping gas canister on a fire or try to heat it artificially. Not even when it is empty.
- Check the colour of the flame: If the flame is burning blue it is fine. If it is burning with an orange or yellow flame or is creating sooty stains on your stove you may have a problem with your stove, do not use it.
- Never attempt to refill a gas canister.
- If you smell gas or think you have a leak turn the stove off if possible. Evacuate the area and get help from a steward or on site fire team.

If you cook, always do it outside, ensure that there is constant supervision and keep well away from any flammable materials.

Always change camping gas cylinders outside tents - never inside - even if it is raining. When changing gas cylinders, ensure gas tap is in the 'off' position; otherwise the gas will ignite when the cylinder is pierced and you could get burned, sometimes badly.

Do not smoke when changing gas cylinders.

### Fire Safety

There are clearly marked fire lanes in all the campsites. You must not pitch your tent within these lanes and you must keep them clear of all your belongings. They are in place to let emergency vehicles reach tents in the event of an emergency. If you pitch your tent within the fire lanes it will be removed, even if you are not present. If this happens please report to the Welfare Tent where it will have been taken. If you are unsure of where the fire lanes are, please ask a Steward.

DO NOT light fires or BBQ's. Local fire regulations do not permit fires or BBQ's anywhere on the festival site, as they could prove fatal due to the close proximity of the tents. Regular patrols will be made of the campsites to ensure that fires are not being lit. All fires will be extinguished.

There are also fire observation towers throughout the campsites. Anyone who does not co-operate with security and continues to behave anti socially may face eviction from site.

Candles are very dangerous; battery powered torches are much safer.

## Lockers

This year GlobalGathering will again offer personal item lockers.

The lockers will hold small items such as wallets, cameras, passports, prescription medication, mp3 players and phones etc. Plus they also have a 12v cigarette lighter style power outlet for you to charge your phone! From the power outlet you can plug in an in-car charger to make sure your phone, mp3 player and camera stay working all weekend long. Most phone chargers are available to purchase from [www.lockerhouse.co.uk](http://www.lockerhouse.co.uk) or on site (subject to availability) or of course you can bring your own. The lockers are open and security managed 24 hrs a day. CCTV is also fitted for added security of your belongings.

Once you have booked you will receive an electronic voucher 7 days prior to the festival which will enable you to register swiftly at the Lockerhouse Box Office which you will find adjacent to the lockers on site - saving precious time to see more acts, take more photos and party longer! Please see [www.lockerhouse.co.uk](http://www.lockerhouse.co.uk) for further updates of site locations etc. as they become available.

Lockers are located in the Campsites - only purchase if you have a camping ticket.

## Toilets

There are toilets in the campsites and the arena that are cleaned and emptied throughout the weekend. We all know that festival toilets can generally be unpleasant to use, so please help us by keeping them clean; it will be mutually beneficial. Always wash your hands after using the toilets.

## Rubbish & Waste

There are plenty of bins provided, which are emptied during the weekend. Bin bags are provided in the campsites.

## Valuables

If you don't need it - don't bring it! Carry money, credit cards, mobile phones, cameras, and all other valuables with you at all times. Do not assume that you have hidden it well in your tent. GlobalGathering has a very good safety history however festivals do attract criminals who tour festivals and steal from tents and cars. We work closely with the Police and Security to try to alleviate the problems but please ensure that you look after your valuables. Lockers are available to hire.

Mark your property with your name and postcode only, thieves do not want marked property and it will significantly reduce the risk of items being stolen. Tag your keys with your phone number and a friend's address (not your address). We find many keys after the event and marking them means we can contact you.

Leave your tent untidy - don't make it easy for thieves to grab a bag with everything in it. When asleep, hide your money and all other valuables carefully and do not put everything together. Too much drink can make you sleep heavily and you may not hear somebody entering your tent. If you see anybody acting suspiciously anywhere in the festival site please alert a Steward or the Police.

If you think you have had an item stolen, please go to the Welfare Tent as it may have been handed in before reporting a theft to the Police.

- Ensure you know where your nearest emergency exits are.
- Follow any instructions given by Stewards or Security.

Move away from any dangerous/antisocial behaviour and alert Security if they are not already in the immediate vicinity.

## Drinks

You can bring up to 2 litres of water and soft drinks (no alcohol) into the festival. It must be in a plastic, foil or cardboard container of not more than 1 litre in size. Due to licensing restrictions no drinks can be taken between the campsite and the arena.

## Water

It is important to stay hydrated whilst at the festival so make sure you take advantage of the standpipes that contain FREE drinking water in the campsites and the arena.

## Arena Admission Policy

All tented structures have a set capacity that, by law, we cannot exceed. If there is a particular artist you want to see, you should check their performance time and ensure you are there early, as we cannot guarantee admittance to these areas. Closed-off structures will not be re-opened until after the act has finished. If you cannot get access, we recommend you go and enjoy a performance at an alternative stage.

## Cash Machines

There will be several cash machines throughout the festival site, campsite and at the box offices but we do advise that you come prepared. Although every effort is made to keep the cash points stocked the sheer volume of people using them can sometimes prohibit this.

## Emergency Services

There is a 24 hour medical centre and other first aid points with fully qualified doctors, nurses, ambulances and St John's staff. Please familiarise yourself with their location. There are also trained welfare staff, to help with personal problems, who are available 24 hours and situated in the Welfare Tent.

Full emergency services include Police, Ambulance and Fire Service. If you need any assistance DO NOT call 999 as you will unnecessarily tie up services from a nearby town. There are an ample number of Stewards and Security on site who can be alerted to call upon emergency services or assist as necessary.

We have a full chemist on site however, please be aware that no prescription drugs are available. Look after yourself and those around you, even people you don't know. If you suspect somebody is unwell take him or her to the first aid tent. If they are not moving, please alert a Steward immediately who will call for the necessary help. Please do not attempt to move them as you may do more harm than good.

If you need to take medication regularly remember to bring it and let your friends know of any illness or allergies you may have.

## Special Needs

GlobalGathering welcomes people with special needs. Every year we try to provide the best and most appropriate facilities possible.

Please call **01789 730558** to register for information. If you require a carer, they can accompany you to the event free of charge.

You will need to purchase a ticket at full price by calling Ticketmaster on **0844 847 1551**. A copy of this, along with your certificate of disability will need to be sent to the address given to you when you register your information.

Please note that as the event is held in a rural setting manoeuvring a wheelchair can be difficult in some areas of the site, particularly if there are adverse weather conditions. We do our best to provide facilities to assist with this.

There are welfare points within the festival and the campsite and staff will be on hand to assist with any queries you have. The campsite welfare point will be open 24hrs during the festival.

Special accommodation requests for the disabled camping area (i.e. not tents) will be considered in advance.

## Disabled Parking:

Disabled parking is provided free of charge. Cars are asked to display the relevant official disability badge where appropriate.

## Disabled Viewing Platform:

There will be a disabled viewing platform in the main stage arena. It is our policy that you can access the platform with one carer only.

## Disabled Toilets:

There are toilets for disabled persons throughout the festival site at toilet blocks and welfare points.

## Recharging Electric Wheelchairs:

Facilities are provided at the welfare points to recharge electric wheelchairs. Please ask the stewards or one of the staff for assistance.
